# Return to School – Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> August 2022

We hope that you and your family are enjoying the summer break. It is still a while off yet, however, to support with any *back-to-school* preparation nearer the time, see some key information below.

## What will I need?

Early Learning and Childcare: ALL items should have your child's name clearly marked Children are to arrive dressed in clothes that they are comfortable to play in both outdoors and indoors, including a jacket and footwear. In a bag, it is helpful if children have a full change of clothes and a change of shoes.

## P1-P7: ALL items should have your child's name clearly marked

Children spend time outdoors both at break times and when learning outdoors. Each day children should have a jacket with them for our ever-changing Scottish weather.

In terms of footwear, your child may find it to be more practical and economical to wear a trainer (that is more versatile) than a school shoe.

We will be using cloakrooms for all children again this year. It is asked that children have a change of shoes that can be left in school, e.g. plimsolls or trainers, when the shoes that they wear outdoors become too grubby for classrooms, the dining hall and PE hall.

Children have access to water fountains – a water bottle is recommended in your child's school bag.

Children may wish to bring a pencil case, however, this is not an expectation.

The core uniform includes (these do not need to be embroidered):

- Navy blue school sweatshirt, fleece or cardigan
- Navy blue, sky blue or white polo shirt.

## Early Learning and Childcare (ELC)

Children enter via the ELC gate at 9.15am. If your child is accessing breakfast club, this begins at 8.15am, and is accessed via the ELC door.

### P1-P7

The playground gate opens at 9am. At 9.15am the bell will ring, and children should line up on the line for their year group, e.g. P1 on Line 1. Children in P1/2 will make their way to their classrooms with their teachers. Children in P3-P7 will meet in the hall for a short welcome, before heading to their new classrooms. If your child is accessing breakfast club, this begins at 8.15am, and is accessed via the ELC door.
