Our school car park...

The car park can get busy at drop-off and pick-up. The speed limit in our school car park is 10 miles per hour. This is marked clearly when entering the school grounds. It's important that:

- there is no parking directly outside the school (cones are laid out up to the passing place) we have four buses needing safely in and out of the school grounds
- there is no parking on any of the coned areas in the car park, or on the pavement by the zebra crossing
 we have unfortunately had near-misses due to this
- cars drive slowly throughout our school car park with over 150 children exiting; safety is the number one priority, and we all have a collective responsibility for this.
