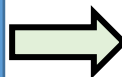
Placing the human rights and needs of every child and young person at the centre of education

HIGHLAND COUNCIL Education and Learning Improvement Plan

This plan sets out the ambition of The Highland Council Education and Learning Service to improve attainment and achievement and reduce inequity by prioritising improvement in four key themes:

1. Leadership
2. Learning and Teaching
3. Curriculum
4. Data Analysis for Improvement

Three foundation principles sit alongside each of these themes and act as a common thread between them:

1. Inclusive Practice/ Additional Support Needs
2. Health and wellbeing, including Relationships and Behaviour
3. Parental Involvement and Engagement



In Team Cawdor, in order to achieve this, by July 2027 we aim to...

- have a numeracy and mathematics curriculum which improves number fluency, supports critical thinking, and ensures the prominence of maths now and in the future.
- ensure that the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) is realised for each child in Team Cawdor, embedded within our ethos and across our curriculum.
- support and challenge each children's development, learning, and wellbeing through both high-quality instruction and inquiry – both outdoors and indoors.
- have a positive impact on our community – both on our doorstep and further afield – using the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) to guide our learning.
- have developed our second language, ensuring that all children in ELC are exposed to language, and all children in P1-P7 are learning French which is progressive each year.

Through these actions we will work together as #TeamCawdor to continuously reflect on why we learn, what we learn, how we learn, when we learn and where we learn.
